

**AGREEMENT
ON THE EXTENSION OF
VALIDITY OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE GEORGIAN
NATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AND THE COMMUNICATIONS
REGULATORY AUTHORITY OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA**

The Georgian National Communications Commission and the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter – the Parties), recognising that the Memorandum of Understanding between the Georgian National Communications Commission and the Communications Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter – Memorandum of Understanding) signed on 1 July 2011 in Trakai, Lithuania, is valid until 1 July 2016,

considering Paragraph 5.2 of Article V of Memorandum of Understanding,
have agreed:

Article I

The validity of Memorandum of Understanding shall be extended for the period of the following one year, until 1 July 2017.

Article II

This Agreement shall enter into force on 2 July 2016.
